## CORPORATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

- Maintaining and continually improving the Environmental Management System.

Barnard is committed to sustainable development, and wherever possible will:

- Buy materials that come from renewable sources;
- Buy and hire local to reduce pollution contributions due to travel;
- Encourage virtual meetings to reduce pollution contribution due to travel;
- Reuse and recycle our waste;
- Implement anti-idling policy and encourage employee carpooling;
- Implement measures to reduce energy consumption;
